Issues Currently Under Discussion:

- Shop Stewards' Training Class: The latest Stewards' Class was held on April 5 and 6.

- CWA Logo Shirts: Shelley circulated the current catalogs so that the Board Members could order new shirts.
- Piedmont Contract Negotiations: Janice discussed the progress of the negotiations.
- Open Bid: No decision has yet been made regarding an open bid for CLT even though Management has concluded its survey.

#### NEW BUSINESS

Contract Surveys: The surveys have been printed and are ready to distribute to our members.

Incident Reports: At the request of one of our members, Shelley has designed an Incident Report form for our Local members' use.

Charitable Contribution: The Local has received a solicitation from CWA Headquarters for contributions to the Pediatric AIDs Foundation and to Union-to-Union, which supports workers in Central and South America, the Caribbean and Cuban Telephone Workers in Exile. The Board voted unanimously to contribute \$100.00 to Pediatric AIDS.

Business Cards: The Local has received a suggestion that we change our business cards, using the Teamsters card as a template, but because that design would double the cost for new cards, the Board rejected the suggestion by a unanimous vote.

Local By-Laws: Now that Piedmont Airlines has been added to our Local, it will be necessary to re-evaluate and revise the by-laws.
