- Blocked CLT VTO for members in September and was extended to October.
 - VTO is not contractual.
 - Agents can sign up in Bidding Hub
 - o Based on shift, workloads and then seniority
- Mandatory OT
 - Discussed with Management monthly.
 - How many days a month are members mandatory.
 - The reason for the mandatory
 - President must send in a monthly report .
- Hiring
 - List of employees AA is 2 months behind updating the list of employees.
 - This determines transfers and hiring.
- Concourse movement in CLT
 - o Moving agents from one concourse to another because of sick call and Oji.
 - Management is monitoring and attempting to minimize moving agents.
- Training Compliance
 - o I-learning completion is the members responsibility.
 - Call staffing to request time to do i-learning when on the clock.
 - Members usually have 3 months to complete i-learnings.
- Start times & Walk times.
 - Members should be allowed time between clock in a 1st assignment.
 - Walk time between gates should be re access.
- Bargaining 12th round
 - AA wants a contract with open language.
 - Article 3 recognition and scope language.
 - To recognize that the company want jurisdiction & open contract language over the scope.
 - The Scope language protect our jobs.
 - The fight is for job security.
 - Article 4 scopes & job classification.
 - Determines what jobs are farmed out to vendors.
 - Full-time and part-time.
 - Tell you who can do what work. CSC, CAR, or contractor.
 - \circ Article 5 hours of service
 - Reduction of part-time hours of work during Covid
 - Contract dictates hours of service, schedule rebid, shift trades, etc.
 - Break periods and how breaks are given.
 - Article 6 Customer Service
 - Overtime,
 - Mandatory overtime
 - o how many hours they can keep you.
 - o Article 9 Filing of Vacancies
 - is at the company's discretion.
 - Articles 13, 14, 15 Furlough and Recall rights.
 - Rights of laid off employees to be recalled.
 - AA is trying to do away with the Furlough clause.
 - Furlough rights furlough allowances and benefits.
 - Article 17 Leaves of Absences
 - Under this current contract we get

 - o not charge members a future holiday when bereavement occurs on a holiday.

 - Hour you are paid for vacation hours.
 - Full-time get paid 8 hrs.
 - Part-time get paid 5 hrs.
- Article 25 Grievance Procedures
 - How grievances are handled.
 - The time process for bringing cases.
- Article 28 Retirement Plan
 - Want more than the current 401k.
 - Retirement Insurance
- Article 32 Call Monitoring Reservations
- o Article 34 General and Miscellaneous
 - Sida Badges, Fingerprints, Background checks
- Article 36 Compensation
